definition

LINE - a moving dot that forms a path. Line art is created by making a continuous mark on a surface. Print out the **LINE VOCABULARY** sheet to learn about all the different types of lines.

line exercise

Print out the **LINE DOODLE** sheet and practice drawing all the different kinds of lines.

famous artist

The Line unit will focus on the artist **PABLO PICASSO**. His use of line is very evident in many of the portraits that he did. We will learn fun facts about his life.

main project

For the main line project we will be painting a step-by-step abstract portrait in the style of Pablo Picasso's *Bust of a Woman with Hat*. Print out his famous painting and go to the **STEP-BY-STEP** to begin your project.

supplies

- Black acrylic paint (small bottle, any brand)
- Brush (small to medium)
- 12 x 18 watercolor paper or any paper that says good for paint (Since 11 x 14 is a standard matt or frame size, cut your paper down to 12 x 15 before you begin)
- 1/2" Painters tape (or any *removable* masking tape)
- Set of watercolors (8 color set)
- Jar of water
- Paint pallet (a small styrofoam plate will work)
- Picasso famous painting page
