VOCABULARY

1. **Line**- a moving dot that forms a path ● 


2. **Actual lines**- clear definite lines 

3. **Implied lines**- lines created by positioning a series of points so that the eye tends to connect them (like a dotted line) - - - - - 


4. **Psychic lines**- a visual connection between two points
(no actual line) ● 

5. **Parallel lines**- two line that sit side by side that are the same distance apart for their entire length 


LINE DIRECTIONS:

1. **Horizontal**- the direction of a line from left to right that shows rest
(Like a person sleeping) 

2. **Vertical**-
the direction
of a line up and
down that shows
activity (Like a
person standing)



3. **Diagonal**- the direction of a
line that shows motion
(like a person
running)
